

Anti-Doping Policy

The Surf Life Saving Association of Great Britain condemns the practice of doping in sport.

Doping is cheating and against the rules and ethics of sport. It is harmful to the image of sport and may be harmful to competitors.

The Surf Life Saving Association of Great Britain is committed to contribute towards and support the UK Sports Council policies and procedures aimed at the prevention of doping in sport and the achievement of drug free sport, and as a member federation of the International Lifesaving Federation (ILS), is committed to observing the requirements of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) as laid down in ILS Policies and procedures, a copy of which is available at http://www.ilsf.org/word_pdf/rules_anti-doping_2004.doc.

A policy of drug free competition with possible drug testing has therefore been adopted and endorsed by SLSA of GB at all events.
